WATER TOURS



Snorkel at Hol Chan and Shark Ray Alley

A scenic boat ride takes you to Hol Chan Marine Reserve, a protected area with diverse marine life, including stingrays, sea turtles, and hundreds of fish species and coral formations. This popular snorkeling excursion from Ambergris Caye allows you to explore a stunning portion of the Belize Barrier Reef. Then head to Shark Ray Alley with your professional guide for a close encounter with nurse sharks and stingrays. This location got its name when fishermen and tour operators realized that many nurse sharks and rays would gather to scavenge the scraps from the fish local fishermen had caught.

Snorkel at Mexico Rocks

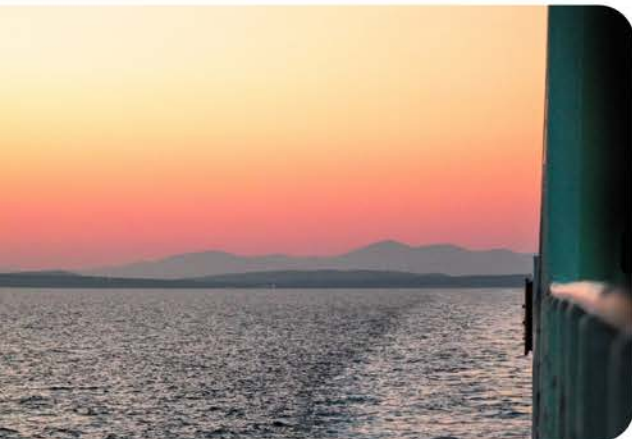
Mexico Rocks is a stunning shallow patch reef complex off the northern tip of Ambergris Caye, part of the Belize Barrier Reef. The site consists of approximately 100 Holocene patch reefs clustered on a Pleistocene ridge of limestone and is composed predominantly of boulder star corals. The reef has accumulated at just 2.5 to 5 meters deep under static sea level conditions over the last 420 years, although it was just approved to be part of the Hol Chan Marine Reserve in 2015. This site is an eco-tourism gem perfect for snorkelers and SCUBA divers of all levels.

Discover SCUBA Dive

During the course, you will learn about SCUBA diving equipment and how easy it is to breathe and move around underwater. You will also get to practice a few dive skills in confined water (pool-like conditions) before doing a try dive from the beach. Not to worry, a trained PADI professional will keep a close eye on you and be by your side throughout the course. After the short course and try dive, you will have the option of doing a boat dive. This is done under the direct supervision of your PADI Professional and only allows you to dive at a depth of 40 feet. You can continue diving with us on other dive trips as a resort diver, or use the credit from the course to get fully PADI Open Water Certified.

Refresher SCUBA Course

During the course, clients will go over problem management, important safety concepts, and dive planning essentials. The PADI professional will also have them practice setting up their gear, as well as pre-dive safety checks. In confined water, they will review and practice basic SCUBA skills to renew their confidence and comfort underwater. This course is conducted on our local barrier reef dives. Afterward, clients will have the opportunity to do a shallow shore dive followed by a boat dive, accompanied by the PADI dive professional. If you've ever wondered what it's like to scuba dive, what it's like to breathe underwater and see the world beneath the waves, this is where it starts. Open Water Referral

Complete the in-water training in the warm waters of Belize! Once at the dive shop your instructor will give you an e-Learning Quick Review to confirm you understand the safety materials from the course. After the review, you will need to complete the required skills in confined water (pool-like conditions), and then repeat those skills in 4 open water dives. After completing the in-water portion of the course, you will become PADI Open Water certified and be able to dive anywhere in the world. Reef Fishing

Take a relaxing boat ride out to the world's second-largest barrier reef to fish in magnificent aqua-blue waters with various fish, coral, and stingrays! Your captain will take you to his favorite spot for your chance to catch snapper, jacks, grouper, mackerel, and barracuda. Whatever delicious fish you catch, you can bring back to the resort to have the chefs prepare you a fresh catch entree. Taxes and optional gratuity are not included. Minimum of 2 participants and a max of 6 participants for reef fishing trips. Private boat options are available.

Half-Day Trips:

A half-day trip spans 4 hours on the water with a professional captain/guide, outfitted fishing boats, fishing gear, and a cooler stocked with beverages and snacks.

Full-Day Trips:

A full-day trip spans 8 hours on the water with a professional captain/guide, outfitted fishing boats, fishing gear, and a cooler stocked with beverages, shore lunch, and snacks.

Altun Ha & Zoo

Discover Belize's natural splendor and ancient Mayan legends on this combo tour. First, dig into the country's ancient past at the Altun Ha Mayan ruins, where a famous jade carving was discovered in the Temple of the Sun God. Then, take a walk on the wild side at the Belize Zoo, a former animal sanctuary home to an array of native species like jungle cats, exotic birds, and primates. You will also get a taste of modern Belizean culture with a driving tour around Belize City.

Cave Tubing & Zip Lining

Located 37 miles up the Western Highway brings you to the Nohoch Chen Archaeological Park. The zip-line tour features an intricate harness system of pulleys on horizontal traverse cables, which lets you glide 100 – 750 feet between platforms up to 120 feet high in the trees at canopy level. Guests will be zipping through a series of 7 zip-line runs from 10 jungle platforms! Then, expert guides take you through the ancient Maya underworld –Xibalba. Guests can see crystalline formations line the cave, and stalagmites and stalactites magically appear out of the darkness. On several occasions, they will emerge into the sunlight only to enter another cave system.

Lamanai River Experience

Take a 20-minute flight to Tower Hill (Orange Walk), and a 10-minute ride through sugar cane fields that brings you to the banks of the New River. Climb aboard and enjoy a boat ride through mangroves and the swamp savannah. See monkeys, birds, bats, flora, turtles, and crocodiles as you make your way to the New River Lagoon and Lamanai Maya site. There, walk through the dense jungle and learn about Belizean bush medicine. Explore impressive Maya monuments, and climb the huge El Castillo Temple for an expansive view of the lagoon. Be sure to listen for Howler Monkeys, and look out for Toucans as you stroll through the rainforest. Finally, visit the museum, enjoy a tasty Belizean lunch (included) and visit the gift shop before you get back on board the boat to begin your return journey to San Pedro.

ATM (Actun Tunichil Muknal)

Take a journey into the Mayan underworld for one of the most unique experiences of your life. Actun Tunichil Muknal (ATM Cave) is an ancient archaeological site that contains the skeletal remains of Maya human sacrifices, pottery, and other ancient artifacts. The cave is not only geologically beautiful with its crystalline features, but it is also historically fascinating. The hike includes stream crossings in which you'll wade across rushing rivers before climbing ladders inside the cave. This is one of the more difficult tours offered in Belize, but the experience is well-worth the effort.

Lamanai Temples

Lamanai is a Mesoamerican archaeological site and was once a major city of the Maya civilization, located in northern Belize, in the Orange Walk District. The site's name is pre-Columbian, recorded by early Spanish missionaries, and documented over a millennium earlier in Maya inscriptions as Lam'an'ain. Visit the Jaguar Temple, the High Temple, and the Ball court where the Maya played their famous ballgame. Be one with the Maya amid the birdlife chatter and the howler monkeys' haunting call. Guides also point out various trees and plants which played a significant role to the Maya in ancient times.

Xunantunich & Cave Tubing or Zip Lining

A short ferry ride across the Mopan River will take you to the ancient Maya archaeological site Xunantunich. Your expert guide will teach you about the old Maya civic ceremonial center as you tour the temple. Located on the highest plateau in the area, a climb to the top will reward you with a panoramic view of Belize and even Guatemala. After your visit, either continue to Caves Branch to explore the extensive network of limestone cave systems and see stalagmites, stalactites, and other crystalline formations or zipline through lush jungle canopy.

Xunantunich, Cave Tubing, & Zip Lining

Experience the best of Belize's ancient history and natural beauty on this action-packed combo tour. Start with a short ferry ride to explore the Xunantunich Mayan archaeological site. Climb to the top of the impressive temple for a breathtaking panoramic view. Then, head to a nearby zip-lining park for an adrenaline rush through the lush jungle canopy. Soar with the birds high above the treetops on a series of zip-line runs, reaching up to 2,000 feet in length. Afterward, gear up for a relaxing cave tubing adventure through the extensive network of limestone cave systems. Float along the gentle river currents as you admire the stunning natural beauty of the cave formations.
